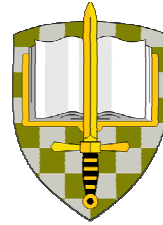

Article/Contribution Title (14pt, capital letter, boldface, in the middle)

(2 empty lines 12pt)

Abstract:(12pt, bold face, left)

(Text „abstract“ – maximum 10 lines. 12pt, italic type, in the block, only English)

(1 empty line 12pt)

1 CHAPTER (12 pt, capital letter, boldface, multilevel numbering)

(1 empty line 12pt)

1.1 SUB-CHAPTER

(1 empty line 12pt)

The length of whole contribution (article) should not exceed 8 pages, format A4, in the text editor WORD, font Times New Roman, size 12 pt, simple line-spacing. All edge margins 25 mm. Paragraph line up in block without indentation of first line, between paragraphs leave space of one line. For text shifting use a tabulator only. Citation under line, 10 pt, left.

Tables, pictures and graphs directly in text, including information of used sources, numbered, in the centre below every table, picture or graph. Size 10pt, bold face.
