








The ANIMAL TECH fair with The National Show of Livestock is a unique set of exhibitions in Central Europe, where producers and suppliers of feed, genetics and technology for breeders present themselves together with the best livestock breeds in the Czech Republic. The exhibitions take place indoors, in covered halls of the Brno Exhibition Centre. At the same time, the National Gamekeeping Show is also taking place. The 2019 edition was held from Sunday to Wednesday, which once again raised the interest of the professional public. ANIMAL TECH is nowadays the only fair at the Brno Exhibition Centre, where technologies for livestock production can be presented; since 2020, the TECHAGRO fair has been fully focused on crop production.



WHAT WAS SAID ABOUT THESE TRADE FAIRS:

ANDREJ BABIŠ, Prime Minister of the Czech Republic:

I am glad to be able to be here. It is necessary to show that agriculture is important for us and the main goal of farmers is to feed our population. We are not self-sufficient and we should think more of future generations, sufficiency of water and other issues. I keep my fingers crossed for all the farmers to do well, because only then all of us will thrive.

MIROSLAV TOMAN,

Minister of Agriculture of the Czech Republic:

This show confirms the high level of Czech agriculture and breeding. My thanks go to all breeders, exhibitors and the Czech-Moravian Society of Breeders. The Ministry of Agriculture supports livestock production and for animal welfare alone we expect to spend this year twice as much money as last year.

JIŘÍ KULIŠ, CEO, Trade Fairs Brno

This year confirmed that the decision to profile this set of trade fairs as a professional event was right. Animal husbandry and breeding technologies are important sectors of the Czech economy, having at the same time a strong impact on the landscape and its sustainability. I thank the breeders for having prepared their animals and came here to present them. This beautiful hall can be compared to the ambiance of world-wide exhibition. If we went to Hanover or to Paris, we might not even find such conditions as the Brno Exhibition Centre offers for animals. This also shows that the Czech Republic ranks among the top in animal husbandry and breeding. This is best proven by

hard figures – in fact, Czech farmers have been exporting breeding material worth an average of CZK 800 million a year over the past three years.

DAVID LIPOVSKÝ, head of the breeding section of the Czech-Moravian Association of Breeders:

We would like to thank the company Trade Fairs Brno for changing its strategy, because the separate presentation of technology for crop and livestock production created a space for exhibiting big farm animals. There are suitable conditions here in any weather and a special non-slippery surface, because we pay much attention to the safety of animals. We occupy the two largest exhibition halls and in spite of that we are almost running out of space.

CTIBOR ZOUREK, Sales Manager, MIKROP ČEBÍN a.s.:

FRANTIŠEK KOLÁŘ, Sales Representative, ALEX INDUSTRIES, spol. s r.o.:

We exhibited at the National Show of Livestock earlier and now we have come back to the ANIMAL TECH fair. We focus on stable technologies, so it is great to exhibit in one hall with animals, and my hat is off to see what cattle collections the organisers managed to bring in.

VOJTĚCH ZINK, Managing Director of FARMCZSYSTEM, s.r.o.:

We have been on the market only for five years, but we have exhibited every year in Brno. We always have a lot of interesting things to do here and a lot of people come to our stand, which we of course are glad about. This year we are satisfied, we had a lot of customers here, our partners came in too. And there are breeders here, which is the most important thing to us.

MAREK FIKEJS, Product Manager – forage harvesters and sprayers, STROM PRAHA a.s.:

We have an extensive portfolio and for this year's fair we chose such products that might reach our customers dealing in livestock production, especially breeders of beef or dairy cattle, sheep and goats. I can say that this objective was met. There are a lot of people coming to us, who didn't even expect to come across equipment, at a breeders' exhibition, that could help them in their everyday work. It has been confirmed that it is essential for us to attend the ANIMAL TECH fair, and I think we will be back here again in two years.

JAN NOVÁK, Sales Manager for the Czech Republic, GEA Westfalia Separator CZ s.r.o.:

I consider correct the two-year cycle as was introduced by the company BVV Trade Fairs Brno. Focusing on crop and livestock production makes sense to me. I see the fair more as a social issue, although I have to say that every day we deal with a lot of business opportunities. Our customers came here, hence the purpose was fulfilled and I am satisfied.

JIŘÍ DOHNAL, Product Manager, AFEED, a.s.:

I like the fact that the new concept of agricultural fairs in Brno has strengthened the position of livestock production, because we are directly tied to it. IRENA ROKOSOVÁ, Head of Communication Department, State Agricultural Intervention Fund:


